Some of you may chose to make other projects with your “**Home Is Where the heart Is**” kit instead of the mini album. Here are some examples you can make with this month's kit featuring **Studio Calico Memoir**.

TIP: Edges of all paper and embellishments inked Tim Holtz distress ink pad in Vintage Photo.

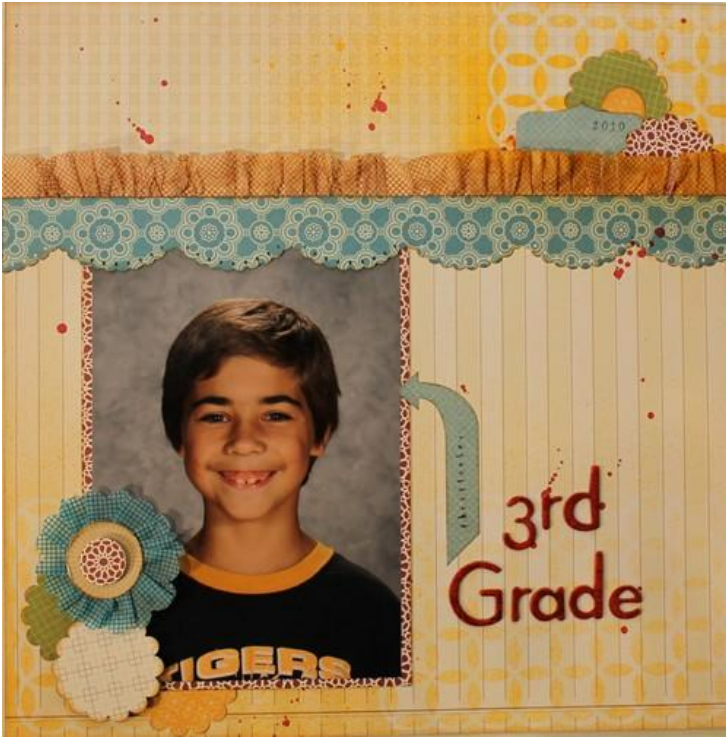
Dad & You:



- Use Flower Bed pattern paper as the base for your layout.
- Cut a 4x3 piece from Book Jacket and Love Bird pattern papers and two 4x3 pieces from Heirloom pattern paper. Glue to layout as shown.
- Spray “&” mask with Mister Huey's Heirloom Blue mist.
- Add 5x7 photo.
- Spray Chipboard Alphas with Plum Thumb Mister Huey's color mist to make them pop and glue to layout.
- Gather blue grid tissue tape along left side of photo. Add sticker border on top.
- Add number sticker boarder to Book Jacket pattern paper.
- Embellish as shown.

Tip: Edges of paper distressed with the Tim Holtz Paper Distresser.

Christopher 3rd Grade:



- Use Homestead pattern paper as the base.
- Gather brown tissue tape along striped border of Homestead pattern paper.
- Cut a 1½ x 12 strip from Book Jacket pattern paper. Border punch, if desired, and glue along bottom of brown tissue tape gather.
- Spray mask with Mister Huey's Custard mist in several areas.
- Unscrew top of Mister Huey's Plum Thumb mist and allow droplets to splatter on layout randomly.
- Matt 5x7 photo on Heirloom pattern paper and glue to layout.
- Using a 2" scallop circle punch, punch several circles out of Linen pattern paper. Place as shown.
- Spray Chipboard Alphas with Plum Thumb Mister Huey's color mist to make them pop and glue to layout.
