How do I register for the Distance Learning package of **ScrapSchool**?

Are you unable to make it to **ScrapSchool** but still want to get the kits? Sign up to be a Distance Learner! The **cost for the Distance Learning package is just \$200 and will include all four project kits and your shipping and handling**. Sorry, Distance Learning students will **no longer be eligible to receive the Make and Takes or the Goodie Bag**. So we have adjusted the price accordingly. We will simply pack up all four project kits and send them directly to your home. Your package will arrive shortly after November 6th and will include all class materials.

Do you offer International Distance Learning for **ScrapSchool**?

Yes! **International Distance Learning Students will pay \$200 for all four project kits plus actual shipping and handling** (to be billed at time of shipping). For estimates on costs for shipping, please contact us at info@scrapscription.com.

Can I transfer or cancel my ScrapSchool registration?

Yes. You may **transfer** your registration at any time. You must submit a written request to info@scrapscription.com as soon as you wish to transfer your registration.

You may also **cancel** your registration up to **October 4, 2011** but will forfeit your \$50 deposit. Between **October 5 and October 18, 2011** there will be a \$100 cancellation fee. Any cancellation **after October 18, 2011** will result in no refund. Alternatively, you have the option to have all **ScrapSchool** class kits shipped to you but must notify **ScrapScription** prior to the start of the event.

1/8" and 1/4" hole punch	Sandpaper
